

Senior Trip Information

Please find below important rules and guidelines regarding the boarding of buses, behavior, dress code, etc. It is VERY important that you read this information CAREFULLY so as to avoid unpleasant consequences on the trip and/or disciplinary actions upon your return. Failure to follow both the printed guidelines and instructions given by the chaperones on the trip will be considered a "flagrant violation" of school rules and may be grounds for suspension and/or removal from the graduation ceremony in May.

IMPORTANT THINGS TO KNOW!

- **Check-in** is at 11:00 pm Wednesday night. BE ON TIME OR BE LEFT BEHIND!
- **Medication/Drug Dogs:** Any prescription medication MUST be turned into chaperone while checking in. Place any allegry medication, aspirin, etc. in a zip log plastic bag that has been **clearly labeled with your name and bus name/#**. *All medications must be in a pharmacy container or original container*. DO NO LEAVE ANY MEDICATIONS ON YOU OR AMONG YOUR POSSESSIONS. Medications will be returned after departure, but it is essential that you give your chaperones ANTHING that may alert the drug dogs. Only bring appropriate dosage for the two days.
- Any bottle with any liquid (perfume, cologne, nail police/remover, hair products, etc. are prohibited.) Do NOT BRING!
- Drug Dogs will be searching all bags prior to departure.
- Remember the rules of acceptable items on trip.
 - **You may only bring an empty refillable water bottle, if desired.**
 - **ONLY** store-bought, **SEALED** pre-packaged food will be allowed in the gym or on the bus. NO other food allowed.
 - If you have any questions about what is appropriate food, ask MR. GRIFFIN in D-36 BEFORE the trip.
 - HELPFUL HINTS
 - Store-bought, SEALED packaged foods allowed
 - Fast food (including Starbucks, Sandwich shops, Mr. T's is not considered to be sealed. Do not bring.)
 - All outside food and drinks including sealed water bottles will not be allowed into the park.

Once checked in, students will be confined to G-1 until we load the busses. THERE WILL BE NO EXCEPTIONS! So...

- Go to the restroom before checking in.
- Finish all breakfast/midnight snacks before checking in.
- If you forgot something, it is forgotten. Once checked in, you are in G-1 until we load the busses.

Please review the dress expectations for Disneyland. *It might be a good idea to have layers on since we will be in a variety of temperatures.*

Students MUST remain in the park from the time of arrival to the time of departure. Those who do not, will be subject to disciplinary action.
